

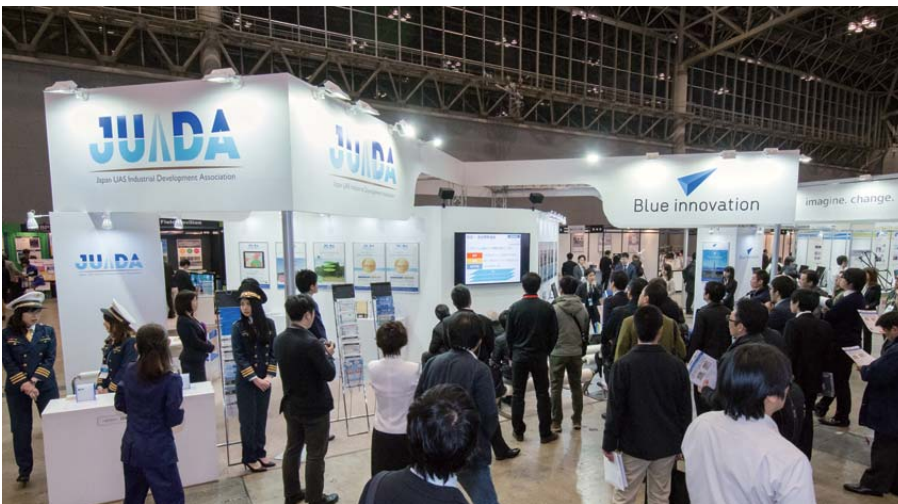


Japan UAS Industrial Development Association

Highlights: Annual Conference - Japan Drone Expo



Japan Drone Expo for Commercial UAS Market is an international trade show - the largest one in Japan, organized by JUIDA and taking place every year in Tokyo with regular attendance from over 19 countries (North America, Europe, Africa and Asia). Endorsed and supported by Japanese government delegates, this three days long event showcases the unmanned systems sector through conferences and networking events designed to maximize the benefits for its attendees. Hence, Japan Drone Expo positions itself as an essential platform in terms of International Networking & Market Research. Activities include: conferences, exhibitors' workshop, drone race, networking receptions, demo flight during the flight showcase, TV live broadcast, Best of Japan Drone Reward, etc.

Our activities

Nationally:

1. Active member of Japanese government committees such as the public-private council for environmental improvement of UAS, the subcommittee on rule making related to UAS safety, etc. to help regulate the industry standardization.
2. Creation and supervision of the official UAS safety guideline for the Japanese territory.
3. Establishing the legal pilot certification and expanding JUIDA's Accredited UAS schools.

Internationally:

1. Expansion of official partnerships (via Memorandum of Understanding) with overseas organizations & associations (UVSI, USI, etc.) to cooperate on national and international projects of mutual interest.
2. Organization of the annual Japan Drone Expo, seminars and symposiums.
3. Organization of delegation groups to attend and/or participate in technical activities such as overseas exhibitions, seminars and business visits to reinforce knowledge sharing and communication with overseas counterparts.
4. Currently working on its ISO application in order to obtain the ISO/TC20/SC16 delivered by the International Organization for Standardization.
